Key Figures: Frido Kahlo

Frido Kahlo was a Mexican painter and was known for her very surreal and personal art,

She was left disabled after contracting Polio at six years of age

At 18, she was in a terrible car accident that left her in constant pain
for the rest of her life – this inspired her to become an artist and not a
doctor

Many of her paintings reflect the harsh treatment many women suffered from men and the law in Mexico

She was inspired by native Mexican culture, shown in bright colours, with a mixture of realism and symbolism.
