Children will be learning about the natural world around us. Through first hand experiences and local walks, children will investigate the problems we are facing at the moment in our world. Children will discuss how it happens and the impact of the problems, such as litter, pollution, energy etc. Children will think of ways in which we can help save our planet and learn to care for our environment, plants, animals and each other.



Investigating

Record findings using pictograms, tally charts, lists etc.

Promoting

Create a poster or leaflet encouraging others to take steps to look after our environment.
