EYFS Framework Specification – this is for my parents and carers!

Children enjoy lots of stories and are able to talk about them. We want children to be exposed to lots of books in order to develop a love of reading. Children will know that a story has a beginning, middle and end and be able to talk about different characters. They will say if they have enjoyed a story or not and why.

Children must use phonic knowledge to write simple sentences to create their own story.

Story structure
